This year's camp is promising to be a lot of fun with the help of all the parents in the planning and execution. We have relied on some of previous years' principles and paperwork to put together a flexible plan and would very much appreciate your input & ideas.

With the co-operation of the weather, campers should be able to ride twice a day, i.e. formal riding lessons in the morning and fun riding experiences in the afternoon. Morning riding lessons will be planned on rotation with stable management.

Campers will be responsible for all aspects of caring for their ponies and the parent supervisors will do their best to ensure all safety

precautions and routines are followed. The ponies remain at camp for the week and are accommodated in the outdoor standing stalls. A "packing list" for your pony is included in this package. Please feel free to park your trailer in the designated area at the club, you can store your tack & feed in it as required.

Everyone should keep in mind we have use of these terrific facilities through the goodwill of the Caledon Riding and Hunt Club. Proper behaviour, conscientious care of the clubhouse and property, and adherence to the highest standards of stable management are expected at all times.

As in previous years, all participating families will be asked to volunteer at camp. The days have been divided into three blocks of time. Each family is required to volunteer for at least 2 blocks of time, or even 3 if possible. It is our goal to have two parents on site at all times. We would ask each family indicate their preferred blocks to allow us to co-ordinate as well as possible. Also, as in past years, there is a \$125 volunteer levy requested for those who are not available to assist at camp. Please note: the volunteer levy should be submitted as a separate cheque, and it will be returned to you upon completion of volunteer duties.

If your child is under 8 years old, please arrange to stay overnight every night with your child.

The first night's meal will be a potluck for all campers and their parents & siblings. A "potluck" signup sheet is included in this package – please indicate what you plan to bring, many thanks. All leftovers quickly disappear throughout the week.



We are expected to leave Wednesday July 4. After lunch, the campers will have a chance to finish up any projects, as well as pack their belongings and put them out on the patio prior to their afternoon ride. We request all parents arrive by 4 pm to assist with tidying the clubhouse and loading their children's belongings. The campers will perform a musical ride for their parents at 4 pm. After the ride, everyone is invited to enjoy pizza on the patio before heading home.

# **Supply List for Campers**



# Please label ALL items with permanent marker or labels

- Riding helmet with full harness including chinstrap
- Safety vest required for cross country
- Riding boots
- Medical armbands
- Shoes or boots for stable management
- Comfortable riding clothes (no jeans)
- Other clothes: jeans, shorts, shirts, track suit etc.
- Pyjamas
- Swimsuit, beach towel, bag, sandals
- Hand towels, face cloth
- Personal toiletry items (soap, deodorant is your friend, toothbrush etc)
- Sleeping bag w/ pillow & foam pad / camp cot
- Sunscreen, insect repellant
- Flashlight
- Sun hat
- Camp memory book (if you have one)
- Games, cards, puzzles, Frisbee, water guns, skipping ropes, horsey videos etc.

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING:** radios, televisions, gameboys, iPods, DS, MP3 players, laptops, cell phones, electronic toys, candy or other foods.

## **Pony Kit List**

Please label ALL items with camper's name. These are most conveniently stored in a large & airtight container which can be left outside of the pony's stall all week. There is a shed for storing saddles & bridles.

#### **Feed**

- Pony's feed, supplements & medications (suggest rationing in Ziploc bags)
- Treats: carrots, apples, krunch
- Hay: bring lots! Pony will be happiest with a nice full hay net!

#### **Tack**

- Bridle with noseband and snaffle bit (&other bits if required)
- Saddle with properly fitted irons & stirrup leathers
- Girth in good repair & properly fitting
- Saddles pads (at least 2)

## **Equipment**

- 2 halters
- 2 cotton lead shanks
- 8 foot rope to tie at back of stall
- Cooler, fly sheet or anti-sweat sheet (optional)
- 3 buckets: 1 for grain, 1 for water, 1 for carrying water. They must be large enough for pony to use.
- Hay net or hay bag w/ snap clip
- Manure fork
- Plastic tarp to cover hay
- Double ended clips for hay nets, stall ties etc.
